We are still seeking 4 to 5 people to work in our nursery during Sunday morning worship. Please contact Pattie Gregg if you are able to help.

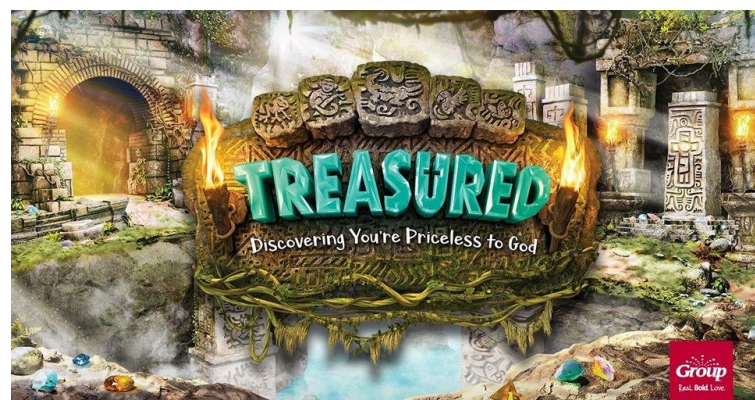
The next **Gospel Mission Workday** will be April 30, 2022. A sign-up sheet is on the window in the narthex.

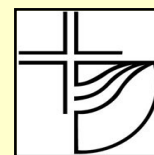
