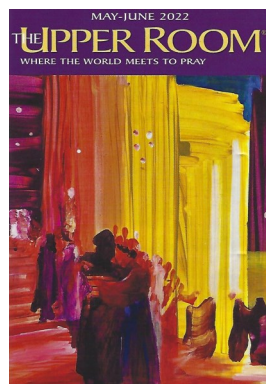

Needed—Volunteers for Nursery

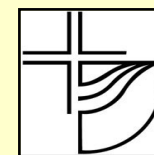
We are still seeking 4 to 5 people to work in our nursery during Sunday morning worship. Please contact Pattie Gregg if you are able to help.

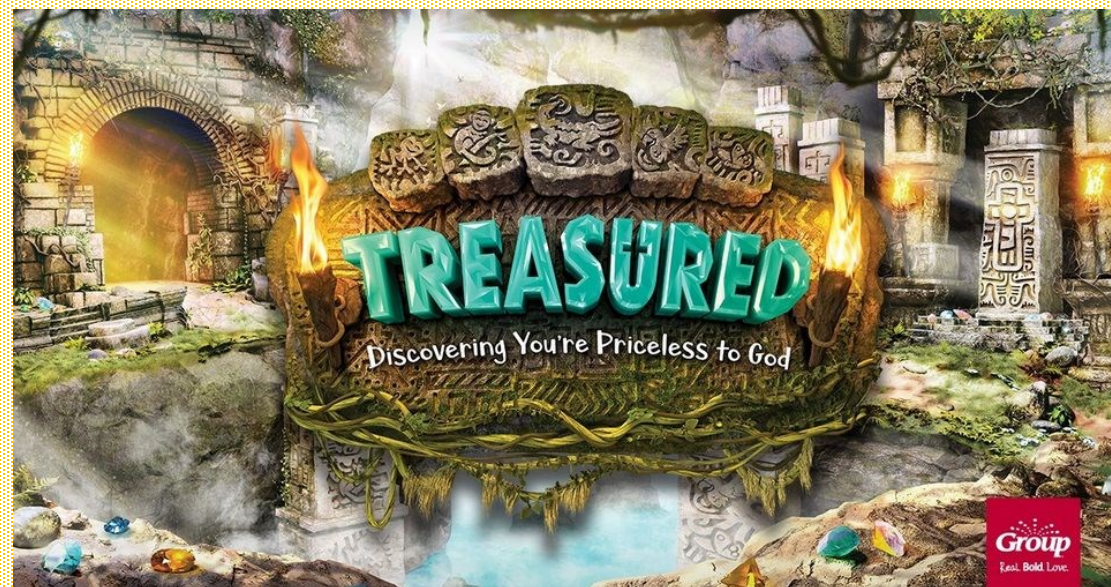
